

 Non-judgmental, respectful care to all patients, regardless of culture








#### **Cross Cultural Care**

#### Sexual Function of WSW

- Overall, same as WSM<sup>1</sup>
  - Relationship duration<sup>2</sup>
  - Psychological well-being<sup>3</sup>
  - Relationship satisfaction<sup>4</sup>

#### Case Example - Mary

- 58 yo woman
- Identifies as heterosexual
- High religiosity
- 17 year same-sex, monogamous, relationship
- No genital sexual activity for 15+ years
- Relationship discord as a result
- Chief complaint: "Relationship concerns"





### Internalized Homonegativity (Homophobia)

 Negative societal attitudes against homosexuality that a person with same-sex attractions turns toward herself <sup>1</sup>

### Internalized Homonegativity (Homophobia)

- Impact sexual dynamic\*
- Not impact sexual function<sup>1</sup>
- Underscores the importance of assessing relationship, not just function



### Sexual Function of WSW

- Special Considerations:
  - Internalized homonegativity (homophobia)
  - Social Acceptance/Affirmation
  - Heteronormative definition of sex



#### **Social Acceptance/Affirmation**

- Impacts sexual and relationship satisfaction<sup>1,2</sup>
- Not being able to show PDA = sexual cost<sup>3</sup>
  - Social disapproval reduces commitment and investment<sup>4</sup>
- May not impact sexual function<sup>1</sup>
- Underscores the importance of assessing not just sexual function

  - Heteronormative definition of sex



#### Heteronormative Definition of Sex

- Penile-vaginal penetration, frequency
  - Not the same for WSW
- WSW- sex is for<sup>1,2</sup>
  - Emotional connection
  - Not as important as romance
  - It's a process, not an action
  - Not goal oriented (orgasm)
  - About quality, not quantity

#### WSW Definition of Sex

- Ask about sexual/romantic satisfaction
  - not frequency of vaginal penetration



#### Case Example - Mary

- Chief complaint: "Relationship concerns"
- Assessment:
  - Not a relationship problem
  - The concern is internalized homonegativity
- Treatment: individual therapy
  - Shame reduction
  - Education
  - Find a support system that fits with faith



#### Case Example - Diane

- 37 yo woman
- Identifies as lesbian
- Out to everyone in her life, affirmed
- 10 year same-sex, monogamous, relationship
- No sexual activity for one year
- Relationship discord as a result
- Chief complaint: "Low sexual desire"



#### Lesbian Bed Death

- Does this really exist?
  - On average, WSW have sex 1x per week<sup>1</sup>
  - Longer encounters<sup>2</sup>
  - More sexual activities per encounter<sup>2</sup>

#### Women are nurturers




#### Two women = double nurturer



#### Lesbian Bed Death

- Fusion: inclusion of partner within self-concept
  - No difference between WSW, MSM, WSM<sup>1</sup>
  - However, WSW 2x more likely to desire less closeness in relationship!
    - WSW sensitive to threat of fusion?
- Closeness
  - More close = more satisfied among WSW<sup>2</sup>

• Does this really exist?



 Problem is when actual and ideal closeness are discrepant<sup>1</sup>

#### Case Example - Diane

- Chief complaint: "Low sexual desire"
- Assessment:
  - Desire intact
  - Appears she no longer wants to be in a romantic relationship with her partner
- Treatment:
  - Individual therapy to help Diane decide her next steps



#### **Clinical Take Home**

- Sexual function no different than WSM
- Assess sexual/romantic satisfaction
  - Not penetration frequency
- Don't forget to assess sexual relationship!
  - Internalized homonegativity
  - Lack of social acceptance
- No support for lesbian bed death and U-haul
- Use the foundation of cross cultural care
